"Behold, the former things have come to pass. And new things I declare; Before they spring forth, I tell you of them." (Isaiah 42:9, NKJV)

I. When It's Harvest Time for Your Life!

"Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe." (Joel 3:13, NKJ)

A. A Word of Exhortation for You

- 1. It's Harvest Time for your life.
- Just don't quit, and don't give up! (See Galatians 6:9)
- 3. God wants to give you a "finishing anointing" to complete your assignment or task and finish it well!
- 4. God is about to exhale upon your Life!

B. A Lesson from the Life of Noah

1. Noah's first act was to build an altar to the Lord after the Flood subsided.

"Then Noah built an altar and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird and offered burnt offerings on the altar, and the Lord smelled a soothing aroma. Then the Lord said in His heart, 'I will never again curse the ground for man's sake, although the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; nor will I again destroy every living thing as I have done. While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and

summer, day and night shall not cease." (Genesis 8:20–22, NKJV)

- 2. After Noah's sacrifice reached heaven, it became a soothing aroma to the Lord and He said to Himself, "I will never again curse the ground."
- 3. The very last thing God breathed in became the next thing God exhaled. What goes up, comes back down!
- 4. You are about to have God exhale a blessing upon your life. Why?
 - a. You have been sowing and sowing and sowing.
 - b. There yet remains seedtime and harvest—hang in there!

"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." (Galatians 6:9)

- c. Your harvest is right upon you. It's Harvest Time for your Life!
- C. I pray that the Holy Spirit strengthens you to keep your hand on the plow and not look back. The Best has not passed you by!

Hope is standing right in front of you because there yet remains seedtime and harvest. It's harvest time for your life, in Jesus' name—amen and amen!

II. When Boldness Confronts Political Correctness

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy 1:7)

- A. I Was Given a Dramatic Dream—highly significant concerning the times in which we live:
 - I was standing on the platform of Ambassador Auditorium in Pasadena,
 California, holding an ancient scroll like a prophet of old with the sense of holiness all around me.

- 2. As I unrolled the parchment, ink appeared and it read, "God has not given us a spirit of fear." (2 Timothy 1:7) As unusual authority was all over me, I read it aloud.
- 3. Suddenly Ché Ahn, founding apostle of HIM, was standing on my right side. Then Cindy Jacobs, founder of Generals International, a globally respected prophet, was standing at my right side.
- 4. The three of us were now in agreement as apostles and prophets together, and we released together the Spirit of Boldness upon the Body of Christ to confront the spirit of passivity and intimidation that had been permeating the atmosphere in the greater society.
- B. I woke up out of this dream encounter, and my bedroom was filled with "Divine Knowledge," knowing things I previously did not know:
 - 1. The Greek word in scripture used for "fear" was not the normal word "phero," but another word.
 - 2. I knew there was more to this scripture than what I had been taught.
 - 3. I knew it was important to grasp this message.
 - 4. I knew it was imperative that we walk in humility and yet boldness.
 - 5. I learned the Greek word translated "fear" as used in 2 Timothy 1:7 is "adleio":
 - a. Meaning: coward or cowardice.
 - b. It's used only twice in the entire New Testament.
 - c. The Holy Spirit is pointing out a place where we have had common ground with the power of darkness, and He's calling us into repentance.
 - d. The Holy Spirit wants to clothe us with its opposite, the Spirit of Boldness.
- C. God Wants to Expose and Confront the False Narrative of "Political Correctness" within the Church.
- D. Then we will have Actualized Authority to Deal with our External Spheres.
- E. Then we will have Actualized Authority to Deal with our Nation!
- F. Iesus wants to overturn a few more tables!

III. When the Greater Works Generation Arises!

A requirement to move into the Greater Works of Jesus: We need a convergence between the two very necessary, complementary aspects of the Kingdom of God—the Word of God and the Spirit of God.

We must return to the Acts 13 model in which the School of the Word and the School of the Spirit cooperate together. (See Acts 13:1–3.)

A. We Must Declare a No More Competition Zone!

1. Instead we need Divine Cooperation.

By combining our gifts in the grace of God, we can step into the greaterworks generation with those who have taken to heart Jesus' words:

"I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in Me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father." (John 14:12, NLT)

2. By working together in divine orchestration, God's presence and power can flow freely and revive the dry places into an oasis.

- a. Let's drink deeply for ourselves and then turn around and release His refreshing river with great intentionality upon others:
 - "Ho! Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy, and eat. Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost, and the Lord will continually guide you and satisfy your desire in scorched places, and give strength to your bones; and you will be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water whose waters do not fail." (Isaiah 55:1; 58:11)
- b. This is a critical and pivotal time where we must see the river of God's Presence not only flowing into the temple of God, but equally flowing out. (See Ezekiel 47:1–19.)

c. This is a part of the New Ways for the New Era!

B. We will now add the BIG "E"!

- 1. We have emphasized the Apostolic and the Prophetic over the last two decades.
- 2. The passing of the last of the Healing Evangelists, Morris Cerullo (1931–2020) and the passing of the Power Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke (1940–2019) was a major demarcation.
- 3. Now we will see a New Era of the Evangelist emerge once again, the primary missing ingredient for the release of the Greater Works Generation.
- 4. It's time to go APE!
- 5. The time is NOW!

IV. When the Power of Gratitude Opens the Way Forward

"Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" (Luke 17:18, KJV)

- A. **Ten Desperate Lepers Were Cleansed of Their Dreadful Disease by the Messiah, our Lord Jesus Christ.** But surprisingly, only one of these former lepers returned to give glory to God and express gratitude with thanksgiving! (See Luke 17:12–19.)
- B. **We enter the Lord's gate with thanksgiving** and come into His courts with praise. (See Psalm 100.)
- C. **There is power in gratitude!** The one leper who came back was not only cleansed, but he was also made whole, simply by returning and giving thanks for the partial healing he had received.
- D. Pause right now and give thanks. Offer up the sacrifice of praise!
 - 1. Touch the heart of God by being grateful for the *partial*, for the *little bit*, for the *completed work of the cross of Jesus Christ* in each of our lives.
 - 2. We will move forward from the partial into fullness through the power of gratitude.

3. Let's give glory to God by being grateful! Amen and amen!

V. When You Have Done All, You Take a Stand!

"Therefore take up the whole armor of God that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand." (Ephesians 6:13, NASB)

A. We Each Have Defining Moments

- 1. We're at the crossroads. We have prayed every prayer, fasted, taken up the shield of faith, made the declarations, and are learning to be properly aligned.
- 2. You've gone through the checklists multiple times, and every box is checked.
- 3. Recently, in my own personal life, I've been there too:
 - a. My house was recently infested with mold.
 - b. Then I personally had a horrible battle with covid.
 - c. I could have easily thrown in the towel and given up!
 - d. How to move forward now: "And when you have done all, take a stand!"

B. Imperative: Take a Stand, and Learn to Stand Tall.

- 1. We do not buckle under, and we do not flinch.
- 2. Take up your shield of faith, and stand firm.
- 3. Plant your feet on the Word of God and don't budge.
- 4. You will gain new strength as you are protected by the shield of faith.

 Then you will hear new marching orders to walk forward arm-in-arm with
 the other comrades who have weathered the storm.
- C. Victory is defined different ways in different seasons.
- D. The Storm Prayer Has Arisen Once Again! The Storm Chasers Are Here ...

[&]quot;And when you have done all, take a firm stand!"

VI. When Prayer Changes Things!

"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints." (Ephesians 6:18, NKJV)
